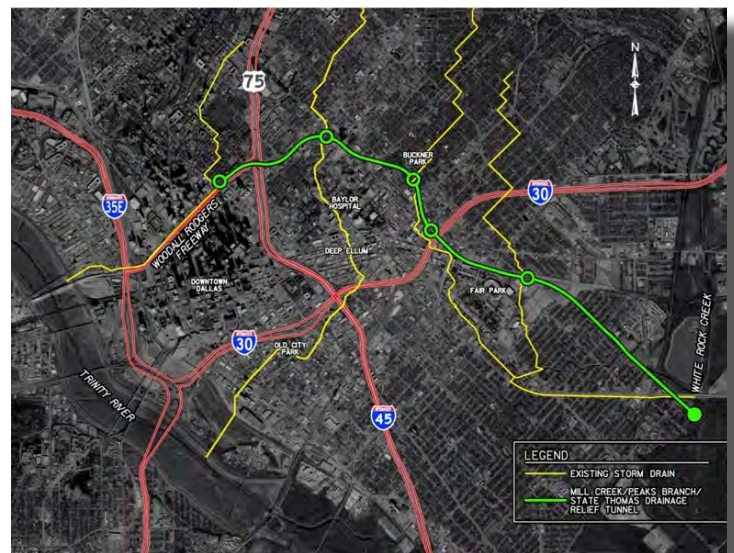

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About the Project

The Mill Creek/Peaks Branch Drainage Relief project will provide storm drainage improvements to the Mill Creek, Peaks Branch, East Peaks Branch, and State Thomas areas of Dallas. The project is approximately 5 miles in length and the 30-foot diameter tunnel will be built using a tunnel boring machine. The project will outfall to White Rock Creek, south of Scyene Road.
